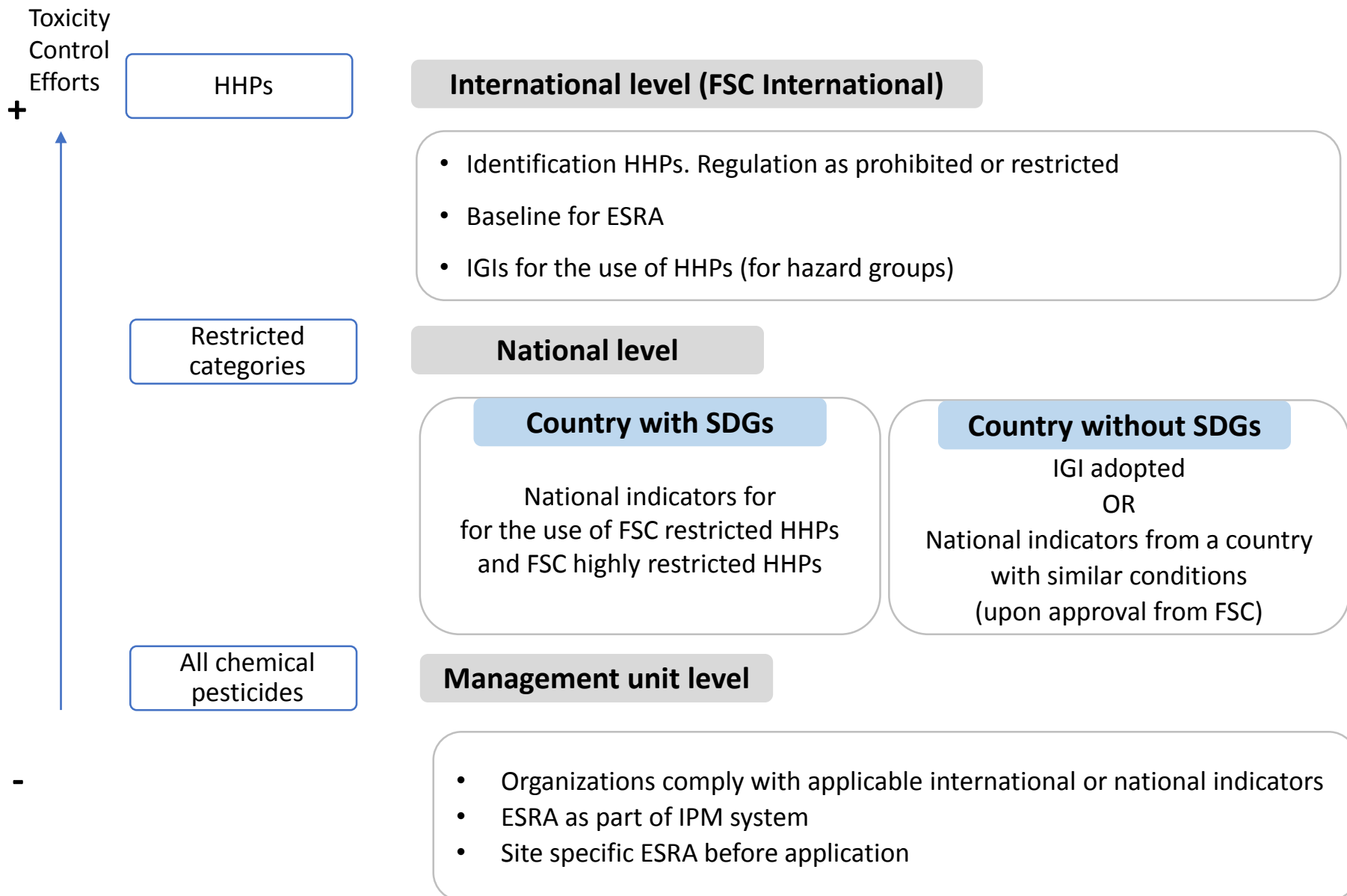


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Regulation of use chemical pesticides

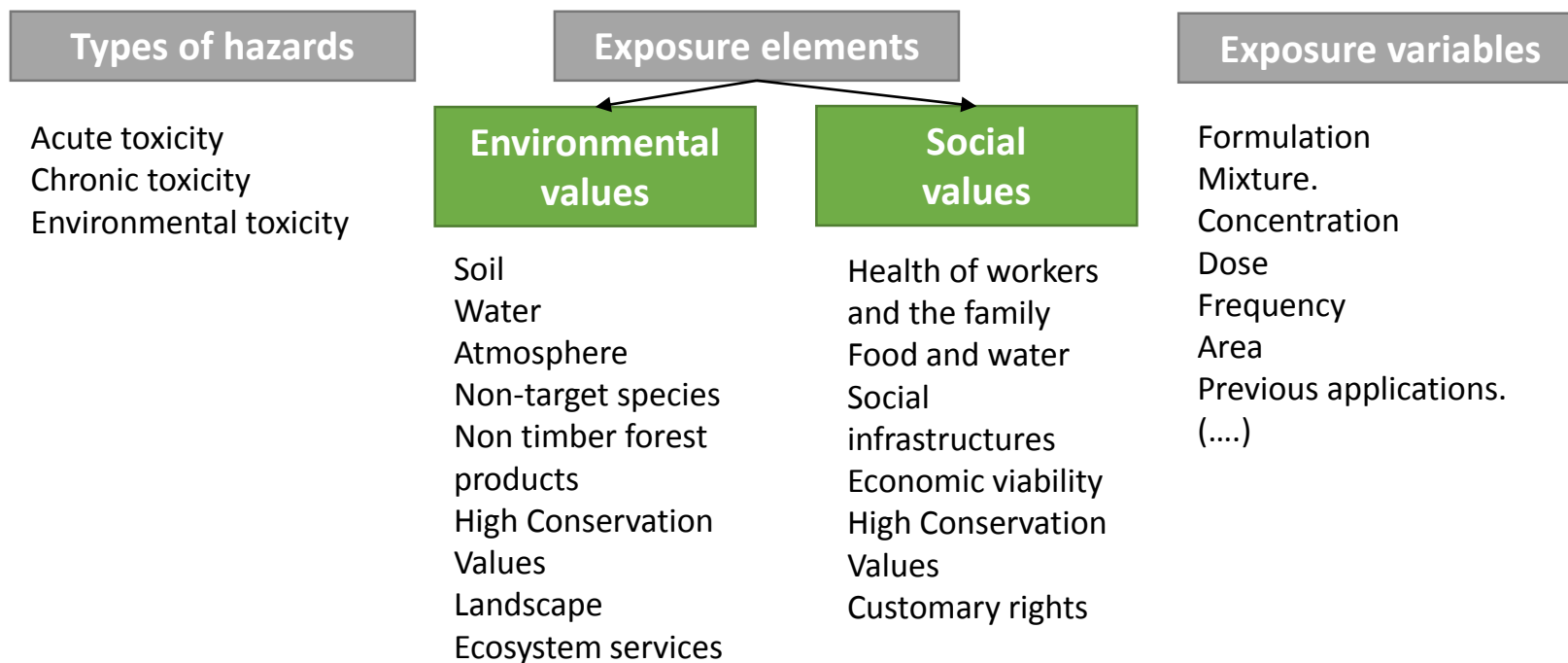


ESRA framework

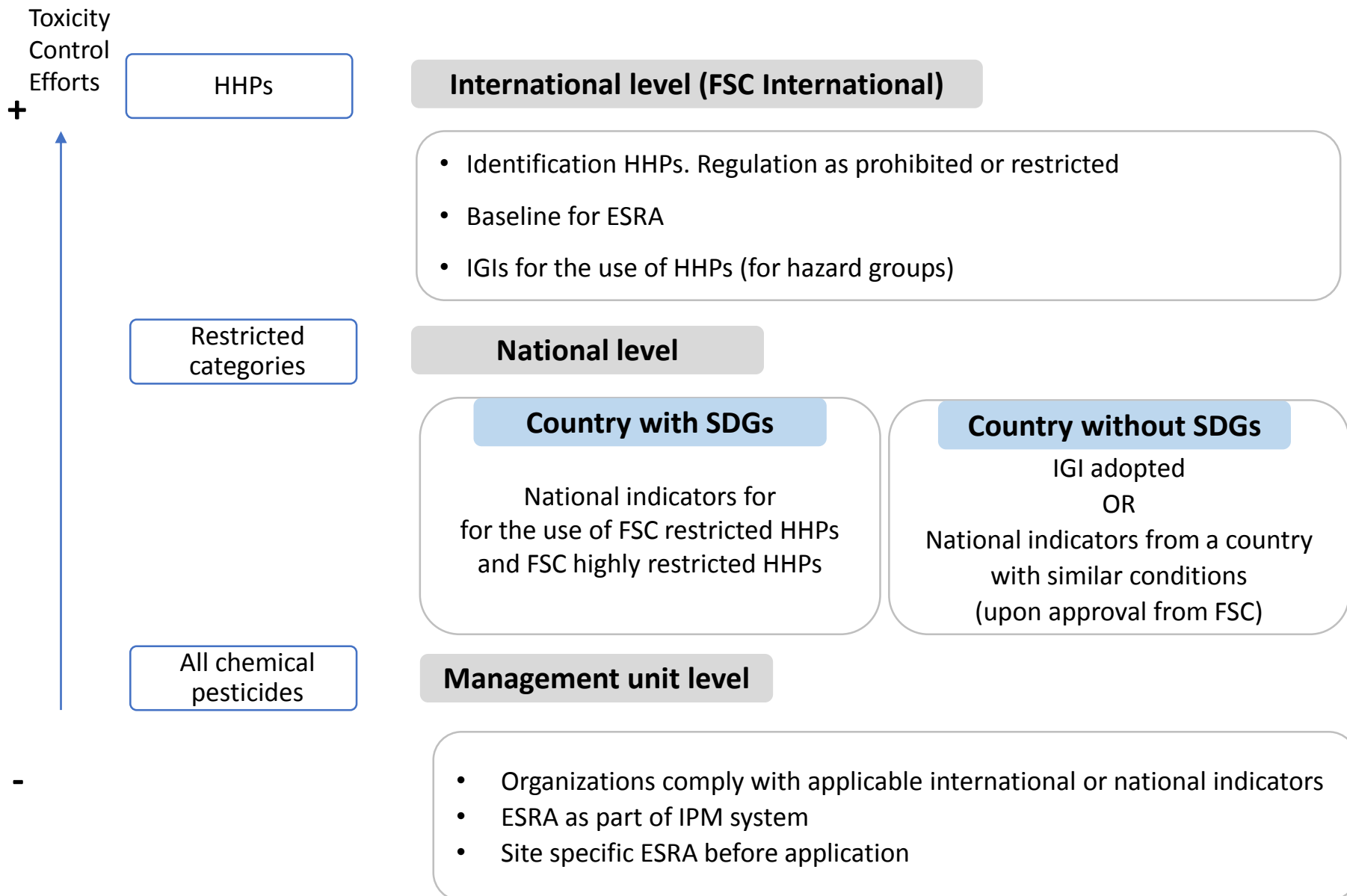


ESRA framework (Annex 2)
